We have settled into school and our routines are now more familiar. Please remember that it is vital for your child to practise the spelling words during the week and also to read every day.

In the next month, the children will looking at the features of a non-chronological report. They will be continuing their work on relative pronouns and clauses. There will be a test at the end of the unit. They will then move on to identifying the features of plays, as well as revising dialogues and how to write them. We ALWAYS need to check our work.

In Maths we will be working on converting measures such as litres to millilitres. Then we will be working with time. It is always a surprise to find that many children do not know how to tell the time; they can only read the numbers on a digital dial. We will then look into various subtraction strategies.

In Science we are continuing our investigation into micro-organisms. We will learn how to interpret food chains and to make our own. After the unit test, we will then move on to 'Plant Life Cycles'.

We have new Geography books and so in the first unit we will be looking at volcanoes and earthquakes. We will discover how the Earth is formed, and how and why it is still changing.

In History we will continue our journey in Ancient Greece, learning about the people and the culture as well as the language. We will learn



about some of the great battles they fought and some of the famous people that lived so long ago. We will find out how their influence has an impact even today!
