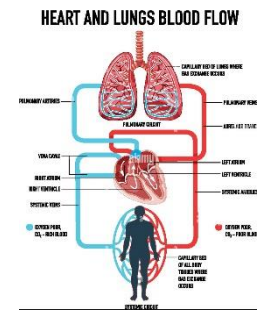


Welcome back!
