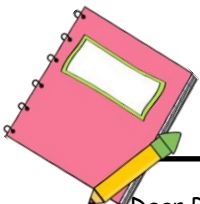


Year 5 - Class News

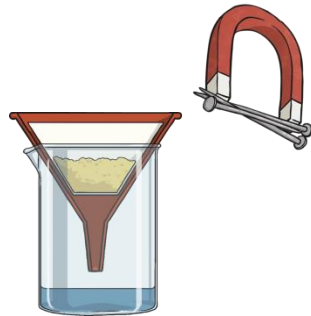

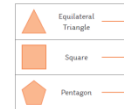

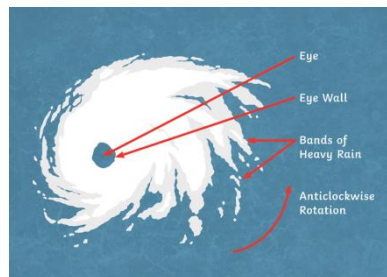
